Guidance for Dog Owners using the Millennium Green.

The objective of this short guide is to ensure that dogs enjoy the Millennium Green in harmony with everybody else using the Green.

Dogs with responsible owners are welcome on the Millennium Green. Being a responsible owner is straightforward:

1. Ensure your dog is under control at all times.
2. Always pick up the poop if your dog defecates of the Green.
3. Behave sympathetically to other people using the Green.

1. Keeping Control:

- A responsible person must always accompany dogs on the Green.
- Dogs must have a collar or harness fitted, with a name tag showing the owners contact details.
- Always carry a lead or suitable restraint.
- Ensure that dogs off the lead are responsive to commands.

2. Poop-free Zone:

- All of the Green is out of bounds to dog poop. As well as the obvious play areas, children do run freely though the wild flower meadows. They make dens in the hedgerows and copses.
- Please sure that you carry ample poop bags and always pick up after your dog.
- Be vigilant, its easy to miss a poop in the dark, in the woods, distracted by the kids, etc
- Please don't be offended if someone points out that your dog has pooped without your knowledge.
